

## Thornton Creek Information

Thornton Creek has historically had high application levels and robust waiting lists for kindergarten. When additional kindergarten classes have been added, they have easily been filled. There is pent up demand for admission to Thornton Creek option school.

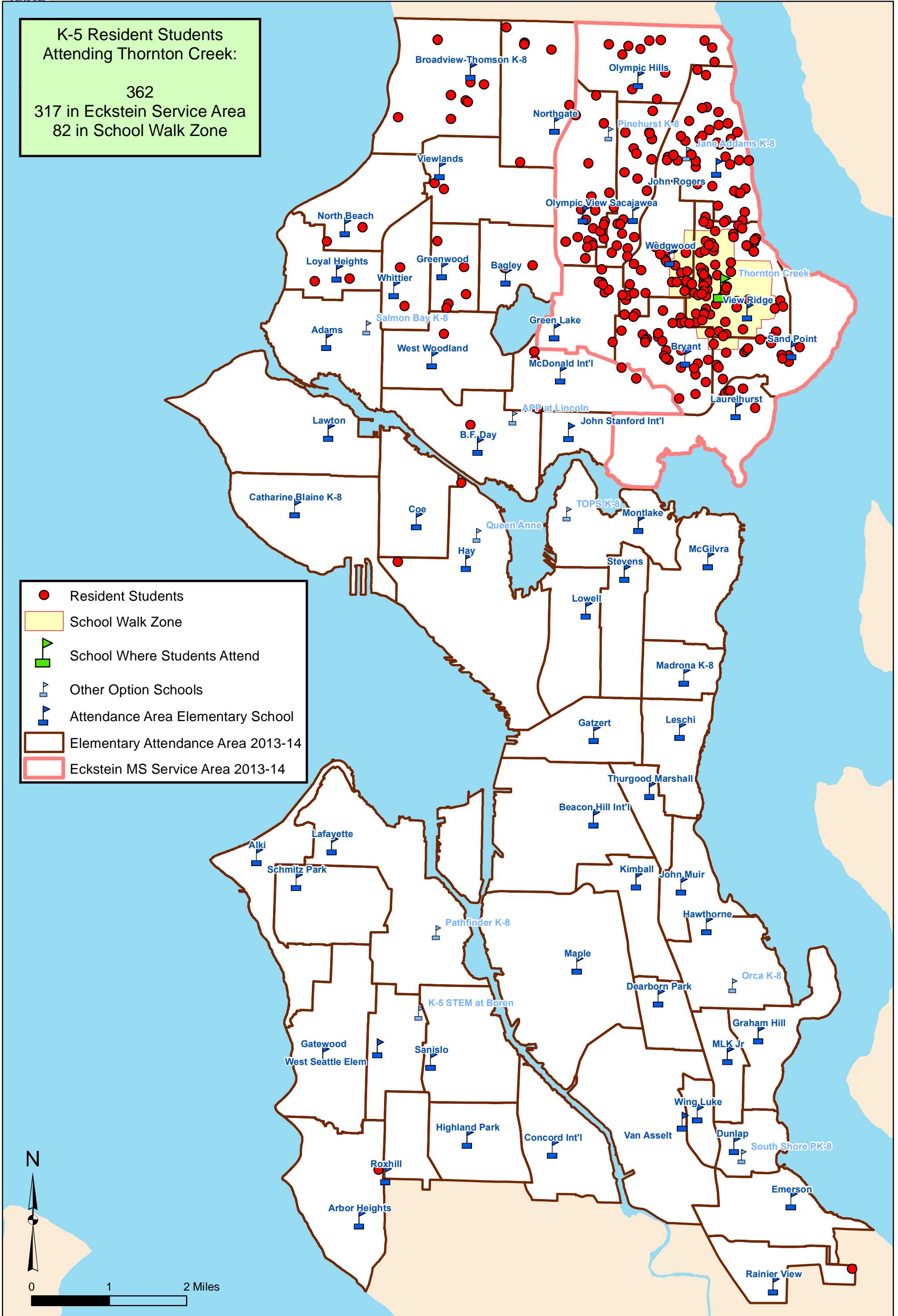
An attendance area boundary could be drawn for an attendance area school on the Decatur site. However, because that area is densely populated, the boundaries between such a Decatur attendance area school and other nearby schools (particularly View Ridge, Wedgwood and Bryant) would be extremely close to each of those schools.

As an expanded option school at the Decatur site, Thornton Creek provides a low-impact tool for capacity management. Specifically, the Geographic Priority Zone (GeoZone) for option schools can be changed as needed to manage capacity without having to change boundary lines. For 2013-14, the GeoZone was defined as the attendance area boundaries for View Ridge and Wedgwood. Virtually an entire kindergarten class of students will be assigned to Thornton Creek instead of to View Ridge.
