Submit Document for Web Team to Make Accessible

To upload documents to a school website, school editors must submit the document to the webmasters via an online form.

How to Submit the Form

To submit the form:

1. Go to the <u>SPS Service Portal home page</u> or click the **Tech Support icon** on your desktop.



2. Click Get Document ADA Help.



3. Click **ADA Conversion Request**. This will take you to the form.
