District Goals

The Board adopts these District Goals consistent with Board Policy No. 1010, Oversight and Progress Monitoring:

- 1. The percentage of students in second grade that meet or exceed key grade-level standards for foundational literacy skills will increase from [TBD spring 2025 data for baseline] in June 2025 to [+ 10 percentage points] in June 2030.
- The percentage of sixth graders prepared to succeed in grade-level math coursework in 7th grade, as measured by the 6th grade SBA, will increase from [TBD – spring 2025 SBA data for baseline] in June 2025 to [+10 percentage points] in June 2030.
- 3. The percentage of students that graduate having completed Washington State graduation requirements consistent with their individual High School & Beyond Plan and having completed one of the following:
 - Dual credit work in ELA, World Language, the Arts, Social Studies, STEM, or CTE OR a formal work-based learning experience,
 - FAFSA/WASFA applications, or
 - Applications to one or more college, work-based program, or other postsecondary program

will increase from [TBD baseline to be established using spring 2025 data] in June 2025 to [TBD pending collection of baseline data] in June 2030.
