## The Source User Guide for Parent/Guardians

Welcome to The Source – the Seattle Public Schools (SPS) online parent portal that allows families to access information about their student's academic progress.

## Information Available on the Source

Information	Grade Levels	Description
Grades and Attendance	All grades	Displays an overview of the student's current schedule, attendance, and secondary student grades. K-5 grades are not displayed on The Source. Contact your student's teacher if you have questions.
Grade History	Grades 6-8 only	Displays a list of final grades for secondary students but is not an official transcript.
School Information	All grades	Displays the school's address and main phone number.
Class Registration	Grades 5-12 only	Online form for students in grades 5-12 to select courses for the upcoming school year using this feature during a specific timeframe. Parents and guardians may view choices, but only students are able to select classes.
Assessments	All grades	Displays assessment results while enrolled in SPS.
Books, Fines and Fees	All grades	Displays the student's current library record, fines, and fees assessed by the school, their SPS device, checked out technology and textbooks. Contact the school office if you have questions.
School Choice	All grades	Online form available annually in February for parent/guardians to apply for their student to attend a school that is not their assigned neighborhood school. Contact <a href="mailto:schoolchoice@seattleschools.org">schoolchoice@seattleschools.org</a> or call 206-252-0760 if you have questions.
Schoology Access Codes	Grades 6-12 only	Access codes specific to each student that enable a parent/guardian to set up a Schoology user account. <u>Learn more about Schoology</u> .
Advanced Learning	Grades 1-9 only	Displays the student's program eligibility and/or final eligibility results from the current identification and eligibility cycle. Contact the Advanced Learning Customer Care Team at <a href="mailto:advlearn@seattleschools.org">advlearn@seattleschools.org</a> if you have questions.

Elementary Progress Reports	Grades K-5	Parents and guardians may view or download their student's progress or performance reports by selecting the left menu item, then clicking the PDF link. The PDF will open based on browser settings. Note: Elementary Progress Reports and Secondary Performance Reports are not on student The Source accounts.
Secondary Performance Reports	Grades 6-12 only	Parents and guardians may view or download their student's progress or performance reports by selecting the left menu item, then clicking the PDF link. The PDF will open based on browser settings. Note: Elementary Progress Reports and Secondary Performance Reports are not on student The Source accounts.
Data Verification Form	All grades	Online form available annually in September for parent/guardians to update their student's information for the new school year. Contact <u>servicecenter@seattleschools.org</u> if you have questions about the form.
SchoolPay	All grades	At participating schools, parents and guardians may review and pay all student fees or fines using SchoolPay. Contact your student's school if you have questions. Contact SchoolPay support if you have a technical issue: <u>support@schoolpay.com</u> or call 833-731-2600.
Snow Routes	All grades	Displays a copy of the student's current year Snow Route mailer for students receiving SPS transportation in PDF format. This same information is also mailed. Questions? Contact the Transportation department at 206-252-0900
Preferences	All grades, Grades 6-12 only	Two online forms. One for parent/guardian password management and one for parent/guardians of students in grades 6-12 to document their Naviance decision (opt in or opt out). If you elect to opt out of Naviance, you will be sent an email documenting your decision from <u>naviance@seattleschools.org</u> . <u>Learn more about Naviance</u> .

The Advanced Learning page displays a table of eligibility results information specific to your student.

Column Heading	Description
Eligibility Year	The school year the student is eligible for Advanced Learning services based on the eligibility decision for each eligibility year. Learn more about the 2024-25 Identification and Eligibility Process.
Eligibility Decision	The decision based on the evaluation for the student.
Evaluation Year	The school year in which the student was evaluated.
Evaluation Grade Level	The student's grade level at the time they were evaluated.
Evaluation Details	A link or an asterisk displays in this column. The asterisk in this column that directs the parent/guardian to the note below the table.
