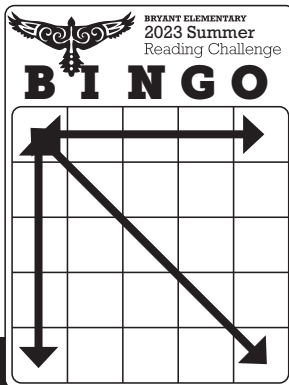

2 WAYS TO WIN!

- To get a **BINGO**, mark off* five boxes in a row. Rows can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal
- To get a **COVERALL**, mark off* every box on the page!



*Crossing off a box means:

- Writing the title of the book or magazine. eBooks and audiobooks count!
- Getting initials from a parent/caretaker on each box
- One activity = only one box

For example, if you read aloud a book that is a Caldecott medalist to your cat, you may count it as either a Caldecott medalist or reading aloud to a pet; just one OR the other.
