 - Your Transcript (Unofficial is fine) February
 - Resume – list and date of academic awards, honors, high school activities, employment, or family support role.
 - Personal statement 400–500 words
 - Attach 2 Letters of recommendation from a non-family member (teacher, employer, etc.)
