This is an opportunity to share your personality, ambition(s), personal goals, and motivations. You may include hardships, any difficulty you have overcome; or personal achievements; Also, include some perspectives on your vocational/technical career choice.

**3. Transcript:**

Provide a copy of your unofficial transcript.

**4. Letter of Recommendation:**

Please provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, employer, coach, etc., but not a family member.
