State Testing

All students are required to meet State Standards in English Language Arts and Math in order to earn a diploma from Ballard High School. The most efficient way to demonstrate proficiency is by taking and passing the state exams given to students in the spring of their sophomore year.

Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA)

All 10th graders will take the Smarter Balanced Assessments in English Language Arts and in Math.

Any 11th and 12th graders who have not yet passed the exams will have the opportunity to retake the Smarter Balanced Exam in ELA and Math.

Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science (WCAS)

All 11th graders will take the WCAS this spring.
